

Amazon KDP Publishing Do's and Don'ts

Amazon KDP has some very strict guidelines in place when it comes to publishing on the Kindle. Keep these in mind so you don't lose your Kindle Publishing Account.

- You need to submit unique content. If you use a ghostwriter or outsourcer, check the content on Copyscape.com
- PLR is a basis for outlining and research, use a wide variety of sources and don't publish as-is.
- Amazon KDP doesn't want to see content that is 'freely available online.' It's fine to link back to sources and include research and statistics (and you should if appropriate).
- However, that should be woven in with your own unique content and if you want to include a large selection of 'freely available content' its better just to provide a link back to the online source in your book instead of extensive citing or quoting.
